Vet records are required, preferably before home visit, to ensure that our rescues have the proper vaccinations and care prior to being adopted out. Your Boston must be current on Rabies before home visit. Your Boston must be fully vaccinated prior to adoption. If your Boston is not neutered, costs can be \$200+ or if not properly vaccinated, another \$200+. Please consider this before surrendering to help defray the costs to the club. We feed and care for your Boston in our homes and our volunteers bring them for vaccines and / or neuter. Providing the records allow us to only vaccinate what is needed without over-vaccinating. The information you provide will help us care for your Boston and make the transition easier. His / Her belongings – toys, blanket, crate, food, etc. – certainly help in the transition. These items should go with your Boston to his/her new home.

By surrendering your Boston you give your permission for us to contact your vet with any questions about your dog's health and permit them to provide us with any records.
